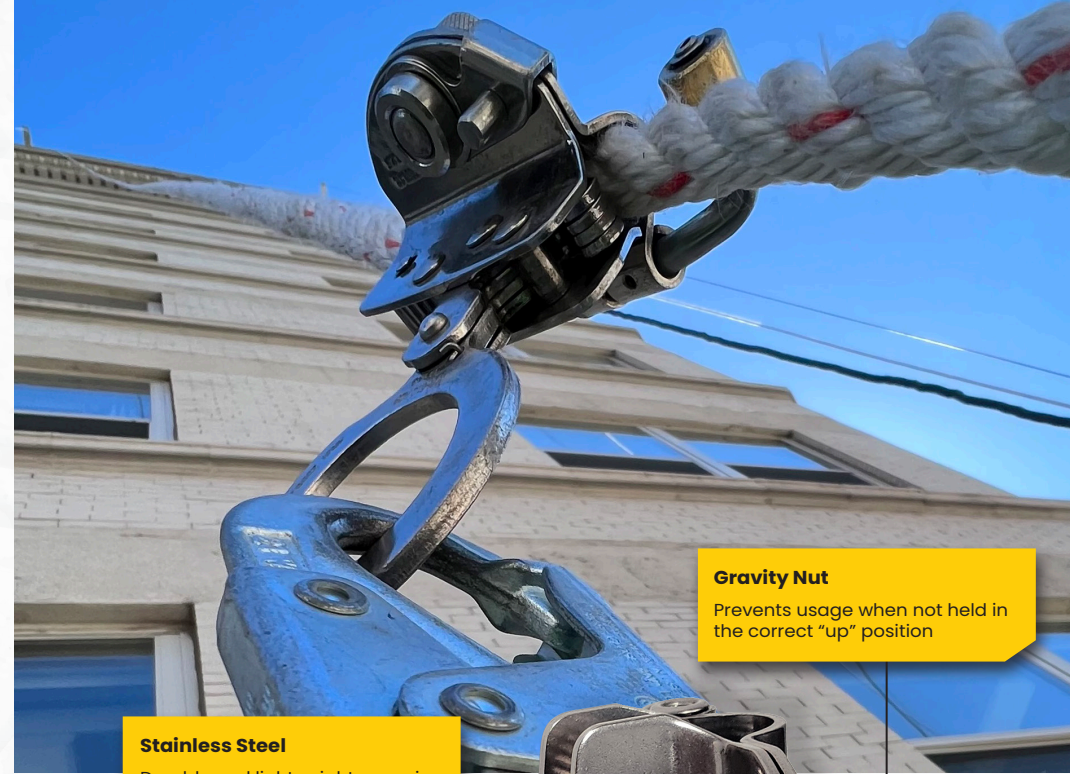

1. Load more than 310lbs.
2. Use this product for self-belay by a single climber. Use this product for use on a steel cable.
3. Remove the screws in the cam.
4. Remove the cam spring.

DO:

1. Only use rope that has a diameter between 12-16mm.
2. Only use nylon or polyester blend rope with this rope grab. Do not use with steel cable. Always use fall protection equipment when working at height.
3. Always climb smoothly, avoid bounce of rope.
4. Always use a shock absorber.
5. Check and clean equipment every time, before and after use.
6. Always guard against anything that could block the action of the cam.
7. Only use this product between temperatures of 20° degrees Fahrenheit to 130° degrees Fahrenheit.

INSTALLATION:

1. Apply pressure on the safety lever.
2. Turn loose the locking screw, until the body opens to 2 parts.
3. Place the rope on the groove of device, make sure to install on the right direction, Arrow should point to the direction of the anchor.
4. Close the body, and apply pressure on the safety lever.
5. Turn the locking screw until tight.
6. Make sure the rope grab will lock in place when left alone.
7. Make sure the rope grab will trail when applying pressure to the cam.
8. If one has a problem, do not use the unit, please mark product as "unusable" and dispose of product immediately.
